Variable: unknown quantity expressed usually as a letter (x, y, a, b)**Constant:** number that does not change**Degree:** the exponent on the variable ($7x^3$ has a degree of 3)

Domain: the x-values, independent variable's values, "input" values**Range:** the y-values, dependent variable's values, "output" values**Scatterplot Correlation:** trend made when ordered data are plotted

Objective 3 – Linear Functions

Slope-Intercept Form of a Line: $y = mx + b$ **Slope, m:** the rate of change = rise/run = $(y_2 - y_1)/(x_2 - x_1)$ **y-intercept:** the point where a line crosses the y-axis**x-intercept:** the point where a line crosses the x-axis**Parallel Lines:** two lines that never intersect; have same slope (m)**Perpendicular Lines:** two lines that intersect at a right angle; slopes are opposite reciprocals (if slope of one line is m, the other's slope is $-1/m$)**Standard Form:** $Ax + By = C$ where A, B, and C are integers

and A is positive

Slope Form: $y - y_1 = m(x - x_1)$ **Variation:** $y = kx$ where k is a proportionality constant; therefore as x increases, y increases k times x**Inverse Variation:** $y = k/x$ where k is a proportionality constant; therefore as x increases, y decreases 1/k times x**Graphing a Line:** find the slope (m) and y-intercept (b)

System of Linear Equations: two linear equations with two variables

If the lines intersect at one point, a solution exists

If the lines are parallel, no solution exists

If lines intersect at all points, many solutions exist

Three methods can be used to solve a system of linear equations
